InvestIn run a number of virtual and in person work experiences in a range of



sectors such as computer science, media, architecture, medicine (also veterinary and dentistry), engineering, business and investment banking.

You can attend courses in person (usually in London, Manchester or Birmingham), although you can also do online weekend work experiences which are cheaper.

Their courses are not free, but Huntington students do get a 10% discount by using the code HUNTINGTON10 when applying.




